Camp Peniel Doctrinal Statement

We believe that all things in heaven and on earth were created by God and exist by His power and for His glory. (Genesis 1:1, Colossians 1:16-17)

We believe that every man is lost in sin apart from Christ and in need of a Savior. We believe that salvation is a gift of God and is received by man only through personal faith in Jesus Christ. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is now in heaven, exalted at the right hand of God, where, as High Priest, He fulfills the ministry of intercession and advocacy for His people. (Hebrews 1:3, 3:1, 7:23-25, 1 John 2:1-2)

We believe that Satan, by his own choice the enemy of God and of the people of God, is the originator of sin. We believe he led our first parents, Adam and Eve, into sin and now rules as the god of this world. Satan was judged at the cross and ultimately he will be cast into the lake of fire for eternity. (Isaiah 14:12-14, Genesis 3:1-19, Hebrew 2:14, Revelation 20:10)
